EXHIBITION INSPIRED EXPERIENCE

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LOOK, TALK, DREAM

In this small conceptual art class, students will spend time viewing and discussing the current exhibition themes and concepts.

Guided by an artist or curator, students will examine how artists have explored the theme and interpreted this into finished works of art.

Students will be given the opportunity to begin sketching and working up their own interpretation of the theme.

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LOOK, TALK, DREAM & CREATE

Students explore the exhibition (as above) and do a Make Your Own class to develop their ideas further from the exhibition. They will create a finished original glass art work (kiln forming or casting).

This class enables students to have direct access to artists and artistic concepts in a unique cultural institution dedicated to contemporary glass.

Age: High school students in years 8 - 12

Cost: Dependent on class option and technique

Duration: 30 mins - 3 hours. Can be tailored to suit your class.

TOURS AND CLASSES

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DISCOVERY TOUR

Bring your students on a journey of discovery through the Canberra Glassworks. See glass in its many different forms. Inspect the material properties of glass, and learn how artists use it to make artwork.

Explore the historic Kingston Power House and how it provided electricity to Canberra.

Age: 4- 8 years and 8 - 18 years

Cost: \$12 per person

Duration: 45 mins

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GLASS AND SCIENCE TOUR

The Glass and Science Tour aims to give students an understanding of the scientific properties of glass. This will include the various physical properties of glass, the impact of temperature on glass structure, and an outline of the molecular structure and thermodynamics of glass.

Students will learn how the scientific knowledge of glass can be applied to the creation of glass art and how this scientific understanding plays a crucial role in the development of an artist's work. This tour is led by a professional Teaching Artist, and also includes a glass demonstration.
